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# THE BOOK

## *introduction*

### *Author:*

James is named as the author in 1:1.

1. A number of New Testament personalities were also named James, but only three are candidates for the authorship of this book:

James the son of Zebedee died in AD 44, too early to have been the author.

No tradition names James the son of Alphaeus (Mk 3:18) as the author.

This leaves James the brother of Jesus, also called James the Just (Mk 6: 3; Acts 1:14; 12:17; 15:13; 21:18; 1Co 15:7; Gal 2:9,12), as the most likely candidate.

2. This James is identified as the brother of Jesus in Matthew 13:55; Mark 6:3; and Galatians 1:19.

Though James was not a follower of Christ during Jesus' earthly ministry, a post-resurrection appearance convinced James that Jesus is indeed the Christ (Acts 1:14; 1Co 15:7).

James later led the Jerusalem church exercising great influence (Acts 1:14; 12:17, 15:13; 21:18, 1Co 15:7, Gal 2:9, 12).

*Date:* Approximately 48-52 A.D.

### *Audience:*

The letter of James was written to Jewish Christians outside of Palestine. Most likely scattered believers after Stephen's death (Acts 7:54-60).

This is based on:

1. Its mention of the "twelve tribes in the Dispersion" (1:1).
2. Its distinctly Jewish content.
3. Its focus on persecution and poverty.

### *Message:*

The message of James is that those who have been truly saved through the gospel must manifest that salvation in practical ways in their lives. A transformed life of love for others should be the result of experiencing God's love.

# OF JAMES

## *purpose*

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James's readers were suffering persecution and living in poverty. They were in social and spiritual conflict. Many believers were living in a worldly manner. James corrects them and challenges them to seek God's wisdom to work out these problems.

The grand theme of the book of James is wisdom. Much like Proverbs in the Old Testament, James should be seen as an example of Jewish wisdom literature. Wisdom in Jewish tradition and Scripture does not refer to intelligence in a strictly intellectual way but rather to upright living. A wise person exhibits a godly kind of skill in the practical matters of everyday life. To live wisely is to act with humble integrity.

The letter of James enables God's people to flourish as they journey through life in this fallen world. It is for those who, though sinners, have been redeemed by Jesus Christ. Indeed, Jesus himself is the true and ultimate embodiment of wisdom: He is the one "who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption" (1 Cor. 1:30).



# KEY

- 1 God is seen as a gracious giver, the unchanging Creator, merciful and compassionate, a Judge, the one and only God, a jealous God, a gracious God, and a healing God (1:5, 17-18; 2:5, 13, 19; 4:5-6; 5:1-3, 9, 15).
- 2 Wisdom comes “from above” and enables one both to withstand trials and bring peace rather than discord (1:5; 3:13, 17).
- 3 God allows tests and trials (1:2-4), but temptation comes not from God but from self and Satan. The required response is patient endurance (1:3, 13-14; 4:7; 5:7-8).
- 4 The primary trial is poverty and oppression from the rich. The poor are the special focus of God’s care and must be cared for by his people and not shown prejudice or ignored. The wealthy are condemned for presumptuous pride and for stealing from the poor (1:9, 27; 2:1-5, 15-16; 4:13-17; 5:1-6).
- 5 Apocalyptic themes are prevalent in terms of both future judgment and reward (1:12; 2:5, 12-13; 3:1; 4:12; 5:1-7, 9, 20).

# THEMES

- 6 The power of the tongue to destroy or to bring peace dominates the middle section (3:1- 4:12).
- 7 The ethical mandate to go beyond hearing the word to living it out in daily conduct is made explicit early on and is implicit throughout the letter (1:19-27; 2:14-26).
- 8 Prayer is the proper response to trials, but must not be self-seeking. It is to be central in life not only when afflicted or sick, but also when cheerful. God has great power to heal, both physically and spiritually (1:5-7; 4:2-3; 5:13-18).
- 9 Faith, in its relationship to both works and justification, does not contradict but supplements Paul's teaching. James and Paul are united in teaching that justification comes only by the grace of God through faith but will of necessity result in works. If there are no resultant works, there was no justification in the first place (2:14-26).

# *S.O.A.P. Explained*

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S.O.A.P. Is an acronym to help you study God's word. It is one thing to read God's word, it's another to study it and interact with it. These 4 steps will help you take passages of the Bible and meditate on them daily and learn something from each of them. Over the next 7 weeks, we will all participate in the S.O.A.P. method through the book of James. After each letter of the acronym, write down some thoughts, notes, prayers, etc. Take your time and allow God to speak to you, show you, and help you.

## *Scripture*

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Open your Bible to your reading for the day. Take time reading and allow God to speak to you. When you are done, look for a verse or a few verses that stood out to you that day, and write it in your booklet.

**O**

## *Observation*

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What do you feel God is saying in the verses you read?  
Identify who is the audience. Pinpoint any words that stand out to you.

**A**

## *Application*

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Personalize what you have read by asking yourself how it applies to your life right now. Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, or corrections for a particular area of your life. Write how this scripture can apply to you today.

**P**

## *Prayer*

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This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this scripture, or even a prayer for a greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Remember prayer is a conversation, so be sure to listen to what God is revealing to you.

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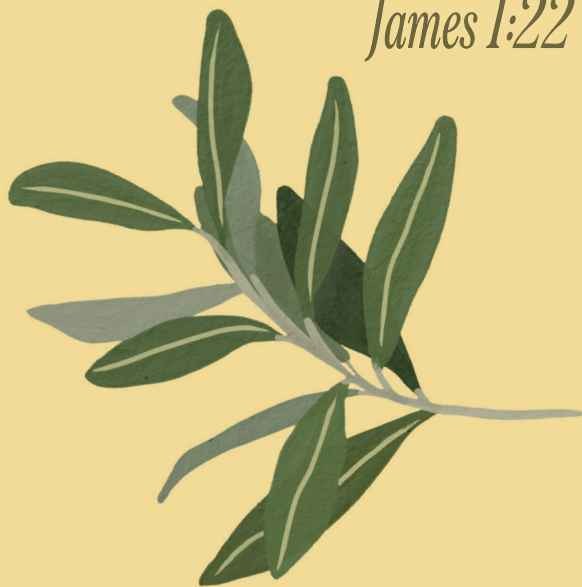

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
